For the whole itinerary, the train is a hotel in which you do not have to pack and unpack. In general, we recommend comfortable clothes and footwear for the day, when we go on our trips and tours. You can choose to dress more formally in the evening, but there is no required dress code.

Every day begins with a comprehensive à la carte and buffet breakfast. This is followed by the tour programme, inclusive of entry for museums, monuments, and shows, and always with by our multilingual guides. Transfers are undertaken in our private liveried coach. There is evening entertainment in the Pub-Salon, featuring several live performances throughout the trip. You can also enjoy a drink in another of the salons or go out for a stroll around the local area. The luxury train is parked at a station platform overnight, ensuring a good night's sleep.

Select cuisine has been chosen for these luxury journeys, combining the most prestigious restaurants along the route with our prize-winning onboard menus. Wine, coffee, tea, and liqueurs are included. Lunch or dinner may be at restaurants or on the train, depending on the daily programme and the train's itinerary. All breakfasts are onboard.







# EL TRANSCANTÁBRICO GRAN LUJO

Transcantábrico was inaugurated in 1983 in Leon, renovated in 2000, and then completely overhauled in 2011 to become El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo, one of the most exclusive and luxurious trains in the world. Since then, regular & painstaking renovations maintain high standards. Being designed for a narrow-gauge railway, El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo travels through otherwise inaccessible terrain. This enables you to enjoy nature in all its splendour, from high mountains to the Cantabrian coast, passing through valleys and along riverbanks. An unforgettable trip full of glamour, scenery, culture, and beauty.

### Accommodation

El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo is the most luxurious narrowgauge train in the world and ranks highly beside other standard gauge luxury trains globally. The Grand Luxury Suites are designed for rest and privacy. There are only 14 suites in the train's 7 sleeper cars, guaranteeing spaciousness, comfort, and exclusivity. Each suite can be used as a single, double, or triple room. Each Grand Luxury Suite is a spacious, wood-panelled room with special detailing. There is a lounge,

bedroom, and private bathroom. The sleeping area has a spacious double bed (150x200 cm) or two twin beds (85x200 cm), TV, and wardrobe, while the lounge area has a comfortable sofa, which can be a bed, luggage closet, writing desk, safe, minibar, flatscreen TV, music player, adjustable airconditioning, multimedia computer with free Internet access, and internal telephone service. The spacious bathroom has a hydromassage shower, hairdryer, and an amenity set of welcome items and toiletries.

# The Salons

The salon carriages are original 1923 Pullman cars, truly historic railway gems, designed and decorated specifically for El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo. The à la carte breakfasts are served in the salons. Enjoy our prize-winning chef's best cuisine in the dining cars. The bar is open 24 hours a day. Meeting point at the San Sebastian's Hotel Barceló-Costa Vasca at 1 pm. Tour of the city and lunch. Our luxury coach will then take us to Bilbao, where El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo will be waiting for us. Welcome and settling in. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Carranza.

Visit to Santillana del Mar and the Neocave of Altamira. Lunch, then we will go further into the Asturias region, to Llanes. Dinner and overnight stay in Llanes.

#### Day 5: Llanes - Oviedo

After breakfast, coach trip to the heart of Asturias, Los Picos de Europa National Park, Lakes and Sanctuary of Covadonga, and Cangas de Onís. In the afternoon, Oviedo with tour and dinner. Overnight stay in Oviedo.

# TREN AL ÁNDALUS

The Al-Ándalus train was launched in 1985 as a way of touring and exploring Andalucía. Following several setbacks, the train ceased operations in 2005 and was stabled in Sevilla. In 2011, the train was meticulously restored and redecorated, and started travelling again in 2012, this time on Iberian-gauge tracks. The wider gauge created more interior space, which, along with a length of around 500 metres, makes Al-Ándalus a real palace on wheels. This is a journey back to the Belle Époque of exquisiteness and sophistication, with today's technology.

# Accommodation

The Al-Ándalus features two types of accommodation:

The Deluxe Suite: A spacious, elegant suite made up of a bedroom and private bathroom, perfectly adapted for resting and privacy. It features a spacious double bed (200x150cm), which becomes a comfortable sofa during the day. The spacious, comfortable bathroom has a shower, hairdryer and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. Safe box, minibar, wardrobe, luggage closet or adjustable air-conditioning are other 21stcentury comforts that this suite combines with the historic train's original appearance. The train has 20 Deluxe Suites.

The Grand Class Room: A cosy room with a private bathroom, which reflects the same size and atmosphere of the original compartments. It features two single beds that become comfortable armchairs during the day, as well as a minibar, safe, wardrobe, luggage closet, and adjustable airconditioning. Its functional private bathroom makes good use of space, featuring a shower, hairdryer, and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. The train has 12 Grand Class Rooms.



# The Salons

The Al-Ándalus includes four railway jewels: its Salons Cars from 1928 and 1930. These common areas are designed for leisure and the joy of travelling in this spacious luxury train, while enjoying the buffet breakfast, lunch, or dinner on board, enjoying a relaxing drink, listening to musical performances, contemplating the scenery, or simply relaxing in their comfortable armchairs. All the cars are air-conditioned and open 24 hours a day for your use and enjoyment. The entire train is interconnected, which means you can walk throughout its length. Restaurant Cars, Piano-Bar Salon, Tea-Salon - you can enjoy every one of them, as well as the service provided by the crew under the Expedition Manager being the guide, head waiter, waiters, musicians and entertainers, cleaning and security staff, train driver, coach driver, and railway and maintenance technicians.



This was the case until 2022, when it was rebranded as the Costa Verde Express, with a shorter route and new livery; a modern luxury train that will enable you to discover the beautiful Green Spain.

## Accommodation

The Costa Verde Express's 24 Suites are fully equipped so that you can enjoy the most comfortable stay on board. The Grand Class Suite is a cosy room with walls panelled in the finest wood, creating a warm, welcoming atmosphere. It features air-conditioning with in-room controls and a double bed, as well as other comforts to make your stay even more pleasurable: writing desk, wardrobe, luggage closet, minibar, and safe box. Each suite has its own complete bathroom, equipped with a shower, hairdryer, and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. A large window enables you to enjoy the landscape. #### Day 3: Oviedo



# EL EXPRESO DE LA ROBLA

El Expreso de La Robla was built in 2009 as a College Educational Train.

It was also used for tourist trips between courses, thus creating a large domestic market. When the courses came to an end, it continued operating tourist journeys all over North Spain's narrow-gauge network. El Expreso de la Robla is a train with a fresh look, featuring the comfort of legendary European trains as well as the mod cons and technological advances of the 21st century. This is a cheerful and modern train that will open up the spectacular scenery of Castilla y León.

## Accommodation

El Expreso de La Robla's compartments are equipped with two bunk beds, luggage closet, reading light, air-conditioning, piped music, loudspeakers, telephone, etc., with a modern décor that will enable you to rest comfortably. Each compartment has its own bathroom, with a hydromassage shower, washbasin, toilet, and hairdryer. The electricity supply is 220 V. The entire train is interconnected, which means you can walk throughout its length. The train has four sleeping cars, with seven compartments per car.





# The Salons

El Expreso de La Robla has three comfortable Salon Cars with a 24-hour bar service. They are equipped with large windows so that you can enjoy the scenery passing slowly. Passengers are provided with daily newspapers, magazines, a selection of books and videos, and television. The lounges feature air-conditioning, loudspeakers and piped music, as well as a PC with free Internet access for the use of clients.

#### Day 1: Oviedo — Viveiro

Baggage check-in from 2 pm. to 3 pm. on the 1st floor of the Renfe station (Counter-FEVE). 16:30 pm guided tour of Oviedo. Welcome on board and dinner, while the train heads for Galicia.

#### Day 2: Viveiro (stage Ferrol - Pontedeume)

Early arrival in Viveiro. We start the morning as every day enjoying a delicious breakfast buffet. After breakfast, transfer to Ferrol by coach for the pilgrims who wish to walk the first stage; Ferrol – Pontedeume (26 Km.). For those who do not want to walk, coach ride to the northernmost point of the Iberian Peninsula, the Estaca de Bares cape, later visiting the Beach of Bares and O Barqueiro, with free time for lunch.
